Who can participate in Virtual Connections?

Virtual Connections is open to campers that were registered for the 2020 season.

# How can I sign my camper(s) up?

You must register your camper(s) for Virtual Connections. 2020 families – you can find the registration link in the email send on 6/19/20. Please register your camper at least one week prior to their scheduled program.

Once you have registered, your camper will be assigned to the Session/Unit program they would have attended this summer. As a reminder, here are the different units:

**Chalutzim** – 2nd – 4th graders (full & mini session campers)

**Metapsim** – 5th – 6th graders

**Toshavim** – 7th – 8th graders (and Pack n Ride during Session 2)

Tiyulim – TASC (Sessions 2 & 3) and Teen Village

Baktanna – 1st/2nd graders and 3rd/4th graders

# What is the cost to participate in Virtual Connections?

There is no cost to participate in Virtual Connections. We are asking, if you are able, to please consider making a donation to support our programming efforts. Donations will go directly to staff salaries and are tax deductible. Camp donations will be matched by half by a generous donor. Your gift may be eligible for the Colorado Child Care Contribution Tax Credit which provides a 50% state income tax credit for gifts to children's programming. Your generosity is greatly appreciated, especially in a time like this.

# Who is leading Virtual Connections?

Our trained Ranch Camp staff will be leading these programs. These staff are trained to work with children and specifically have been trained to safely lead programs in online spaces.

# Where will Virtual Connections take place?

Each program will take place in a secure Zoom call hosted by Ranch Camp.

#### What will each Virtual Connections program include?

Each program will begin with welcoming campers and establishing a safe space. Each group will then participate in their unit program. This program has been developed to fit the unit's developmental stage and match key programming that takes place at camp. The call will conclude with an opportunity to help complete the unit flag and goodbyes. As we get closer to each program, we will send an email with specific details outlining any supplies and parental/guardian support needed during the program, and the Zoom link to access the program.

# When will Virtual Connections take place?

Each program will take place at 2 pm MDT. The programs will be organized by Sessions and Units to give campers the chance to connect with the campers they would have been with this summer. Please see the schedule above.
