


are included at the bottom of the word-search. You'll

Words to find (!): CHAROSET PLAGUES NILE SALTWATER SEAOFREEDS UNLEAVENED WISE WICKED SIMPLE HOWDOIASK Find all ten words in the word-search above. Next, note the FOURTEEN (14) GREEN LETTERS contained within the words you found (and ONLY those green letters). Unscramble them to make a 3-word phrase that plays a key role in the Passover story. It will fit in the blanks below.																		
Once you have determined the phrase, type in the following url to your browser, in order to find the digital afikoman: <u>bit.ly/threewordphrase</u> (you will sub out "three word phrase" for the phrase you unscrambled above). There are no spaces in the url – type all three words of the phrase in a row after <i>bit.ly/</i> in order to find your afikoman. An example (this is not correct) would be <i>bit.ly/thetenplagues</i> .																		

LOGISTICS: You have two options for how to do this activity at your Zoom seder!

## 1. Ask all your seder participants to print the wordsearch. An easily-printable version can be accessed by clicking here! All participants individually, or families together,



2. Separate your seder into Zoom breakout rooms (each breakout room will be a team). One person in each breakout room should share their screen. Using Zoom's "annotate" function (make sure this is enabled for all participants), teams can together highlight the words in the word search, and then work together to unscramble the relevant letters.
